Playing with technology offers a variety of opportunities for skill development. When we sweep with a broad brush and declare everything "screentime," we close our eyes to what's really happening under the surface - not to mention how it affects our relationship with our child.

And all of these skills are developed in a setting where learning is in context, necessary for the game, and fun! (Translation: Much less resistance!)
